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50+YEARS OF UTILITY TO LUXURY

HOW LAND ROVER HAS GROWN TO BECOME THE MODEL OF LUXURIOUS SUVS

Over the past 50 years, the Land Rover brand has grown from what began as a utility vehicle to a luxury SUV manufacturer. From the original Land Rover Series I to their Range Rover family and beyond, Land Rover's authentic 4x4s have represented the true "breadth of capability" across the model range.



Although the iconic Range Rover is what Land Rover is known for, it's not where Land Rover began. In 1948, after WWII, the Rover Company realized that the demand for luxury vehicles just wasn't there anymore. Instead, they designed the very first "Land Rover," an off-road vehicle that was essentially built as the British version of the Jeep. As 'Land Rover' became established as a brand, it later became known as the "Land Rover Series I." Then, ten years later, the Series II made its debut. This model kept the Series I exterior design and boxy profile but added a pronounced shoulder line and offered door cards and side mirrors.

In 1967, the Rover Company became part of British Leyland (formally known as Leyland Motors). The Land Rover Series III launched in 1971. This model defined the SUV's front-end shape for the next three decades when, in 1979, a V-8 powered model was introduced. Due to the engine's larger dimensions, the grille was pushed forward and flush with the front fenders. Just before that, in 1978, Land Rover Limited officially formed as a separate subsidiary of British Leyland.

The first Range Rover debuted on June 17, 1970. The prototype for this vehicle was kept so secret that the

designers and engineers gave the prototype a topsecret name: Velar, meaning to veil or cover in Italian. The Range Rover was met with widespread critical acclaim. In fact, it was displayed in the Louvre Museum in Paris because it was considered a masterpiece of industrial design. It was the first SUV to deliver permanent 4-wheel drive. The Range Rover was first released as a two-door vehicle. Then in 1981, Land Rover introduced the four-door option, and the diesel model arrived in 1986.


In 1983, the Land Rover One-Ten and Ninety (later changed to the 110 and 90) were introduced. These models carried over the same design as the Series III; however, they utilized the coil-spring suspension from the Range Rover. They also offered a more comfortable interior and a modernized engine lineup. These models were later renamed the Defender in 1990, which sold in North America during the mid-90s. It remained largely unchanged from the 90 and 110 aside from updated powertrains until the special edition models in 2007 received an interior redesign. The last Defender was produced in 2016 until, in 2020, the world saw the return of the Land Rover Defender (L663) with a total redesign.

Next was the Discovery, introduced in 1989. As the Ranger Rover began evolving into a luxury vehicle, its price went up. Thus, the Discovery was intended to fulfill the role of the affordable utility vehicle as well as a family car. It was longer and taller, offered more room, and had the option of up to seven seats. Over the years, however, the Discovery has moved up through its generations to find its place amongst the luxury SUVs. In 2014, the Land Rover Discovery Sport was introduced as a compact luxury crossover SUV. Powered by a range of four-cylinder petrol and diesel engines and customized for off-road applications, it was the first Discovery model introduced with a unibody structure. The Discovery Sport succeeded the Land Rover Freelander that saw its run from 1997 to 2015. The Freelander was the Land Rover's first model to use monocoque (unibody) structures.

In 1994, the second generation Range Rover arrived. This model displayed an even more luxurious interior without compromising its on-road and off-road capabilities. It featured enhanced height-adjustable suspension as well

as a 2.5-litre diesel and 3.9 and 4.6-litre versions of the V8 petrol for greater performance. Then in 2001, the third generation saw several improvements and engineering innovations, including a stiffer monocoque body and fully independent suspension with interconnected air springs.

In 2000, BMW sold Land Rover to the Ford Motor Company, and in 2008 Land Rover was sold to Tata Motors. During that time, Land Rover began adding to its Range Rover family with the introduction of the Ranger Rover Sport in 2005. This model included a supercharged 4.2-litre gas engine for rapid performance and cross-linked air suspension for optional ride height. It's second generation was introduced in 2013. We met the Range Rover Evoque, named "car of the year" by several media outlets, in 2011. Land Rover designed this model for drivers who rarely go off-roading. The second generation Evoque premiered in 2018.





In 2012, the fourth-generation Range Rover debuted with an all-aluminum monocoque unitary body structure, a first in the world for SUVs, resulting in a lighter, stronger and more efficient vehicle than the Series III. The most recent series to join the Range Rover family was the Range Rover Velar in 2017. It featured smoother body lines with an emphasis on sportiness and on-road ability. The interior design, however, was the most noticeable feature, influenced by that of the I-Pace of 2018 and its three touchscreens. It also had the lowest seating position of all Land Rovers.

Last year, Land Rover launched the 2021 Range Rover Fifty to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the world's most desirable family of SUVs. They only produced 1,970 copies of this ultra-limited edition of their flagship SUV globally to recognize the 1970 birth year of the original model. Among its unique features were two 22-inch wheels and a "Fifty" script badge on the exterior and throughout the vehicle's interior. The colour options included three heritage colours, including Tuscan blue.

Throughout its 50 year lifespan, the Range Rover has achieved many world firsts and impressive feats.

In addition to the firsts already mentioned, it was the world's first 4x4 fit with ABS anti-lock brakes (1989) and electronic traction control and automatic electronic air suspension (1992). It crossed the notoriously impassable "Darién Gap" and won the Paris-Dakar rally twice. Additionally, a diesel-powered Range Rover called "Bullet" broke 27 speed records during the 1980s. With over a million sold throughout its lifetime, the Range Rover is the ultimate expression of luxury.

In a recent press release Land Rover celebrated the milestone stating "Its unmistakable, sophisticated design and class-leading all-terrain capability have ensured the Range Rover is as peerless and relevant today as it was in 1970."

Over the years, Land Rover's Range Rover, Discovery, Defender, Range Rover Sport, Range Rover Evoque, Range Rover Velar and Discovery Sport have evolved to become a family of desirable and capable vehicles, each defining the world's SUV sectors in both utility and luxury. 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
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Over the past few years, the housing market in Windsor and Essex County has seen a monumental boom with no signs of slowing down. Canadians from all over Canada have been going head to head with each other in bidding wars for a chance to purchase property in one of the hottest housing markets in the nation. From 2019-2020, the housing market saw a 21 per cent increase, and the 2020-2021 increase was 23 per cent.

According to the Windsor-Essex County Association of REALTORS®, the region saw an increase of 132.1 per cent in houses sold in April 2021, compared to April 2020, breaking yet another sales record. The average price of homes also saw a 60.4 per cent increase from April 2020, and new listings were 21.5 per cent above the five-year average for April 2020.

This high demand for residential real estate in Canada, generally, and Essex County specifically, seems to be driven by a few factors. First off is the current low interest rates. Second, the federal government's generous COVID-19 spending and stimulus package. Third, many people who have been working remotely since the start of the outbreak have realized that it is a viable option that may continue long after the pandemic. This has caused many to shift from major cities to the suburbs, thus creating a demand for homes in this region. Fourth, and most importantly, the Windsor-Essex region ranks high in the most affordable real estate markets in comparison to the rest of Ontario and Canada at large — something that is not going to change anytime soon!

"It seems from all indicators that the demand for residential real estate is going to continue for at least the next couple of years, especially if the federal government moves ahead with its commitment to accept 400,000 permanent residents per year between 2021 and 2023," says Ayman Haddad, partner and director at development group Lankor Horizons Inc. "I am sure Essex County will see its fair share of the new permanent residents, all of which will require homes."

Re/Max Canada reported that move-over buyers are expected to be the primary driver of market activity in 2021. Between the ultra-low interest rates and high demand, they predict that this Southwestern Ontario region could be the hottest market in all of Canada for 2021.

"We at Lankor Horizons Inc. work to achieve the minimum possible in condo fees so that they are affordable for people, not only as they buy, but also as they continue to live in these buildings," says Imad Najjar, partner and director at Lankor Horizons Inc. "Affordable condo living in a premium neighbourhood."

One of the trendiest neighbourhoods in the Windsor-Essex region is the historic Town of Lasalle, where the brand-new Laurier Heights subdivision is currently being serviced and built. This brand-new, luxurious, high-end living residential subdivision will spread out across 58 acres of land and be home to 373 families. It will include a four acre park and a large man-made lake/pond facing Laurier Parkway with a wide-open green space. It will also be surrounded by a 30-foot deep conservation area bordering Laurier Heights' west and south property lines.

In three years, by completion date, the Laurier Heights subdivision will have generated over \$250 million in home and condo sales, constructed mainly by local construction companies, local contractors, and local sub-trade crews — a direct, outstanding contribution to the local economy. This brand new subdivision looks to bring more families, both young and mature, to LaSalle with a mix of single-family homes, semi-detached bungalows and condos. Their draft plan reveals a premium subdivision with 96 detached homes, 44 semi-detached bungalows and four mid-rise residential towers that offer 236 condos and condo villas. The condos will be one and two-bedroom units.

The condo villas are the highlight of this development. These 1,600 square-foot two-storey units are located on the main floor of the mid-rise residential towers. Each

condo villa includes three bedrooms plus a den, a living room with a loft-style high ceiling, and a small outdoor patio.

Surrounding the Laurier Heights subdivision are LaSalle's many local shops, amenities, businesses and schools. For younger families, the town of LaSalle offers four different school boards to choose from. It is also just a short drive away from the city of Windsor and the Windsor-Detroit border. It is a short drive to St. Clair college and The University of Windsor. This prestigious neighbourhood is ideal for those who love the quietness of a suburban area with the closeness of a nearby city.

Families who love the outdoors will enjoy exploring the many nature trails spanning 25 kilometres around town. Close by are the various wetlands, Carolinian forests, tallgrass prairies and naturalized areas. Some of the popular outdoor activities include the annual Strawberry Fest and Craft Beer Festival, and let's not forget the 21 nearby golf courses, wineries, the Vollmer Culture and Recreation Complex, the Lasalle marina, outdoor night markets and food truck Fridays. As the town with the fastest growing population rate in Windsor-Essex County, not to mention an average household income of more than \$100,000, the affluent Town of Lasalle has something for everyone.

The electric SAV offers an estimated range of 475 km, making it an ideal vehicle for everyday driving both in the city and long distances. As for longer trips, the battery requires under 40 minutes to reach an 80 per cent charge thanks to DC fast charging. Its sleek and efficiently designed aerodynamic properties contribute to extremely low energy consumption. The iX offers exceptional electric performance thanks to its two powerful electric motors and the xDrive electric all-

wheel drive. The iX goes from 0 to 100 km/h in less than five seconds with 500 horsepower. With instant torque and stepless acceleration from a standstill, this SAV will respond precisely and immediately to the accelerator pedal.

The concept and design of the iX are rooted in sustainability, reflected in its intelligent lightweight design, optimized aerodynamics and extensive use of natural and recycled materials. The front design combines a vertically aligned BMW kidney grille with narrow twin headlights for a modern appearance. Flush door handles and frameless doors adorn the side view, complemented by windows that graphically taper toward the rear of the vehicle. The back features large surfaces and narrow rear lights. Combined with a flat underbody, the large diffuser elements help optimize the BMW iX's aerodynamics and improve range.





As mentioned above, the BMW iX is a much more sustainable concept, thanks to its electric engines versus traditional combustion. Other sustainability concepts for the iX include the use of natural materials and recyclates within the interior and electricity from renewable sources during production. For example, the Castanea leather is tanned naturally with olive leaf extracts, and the floor mats are made of 100 per cent Econyl. In addition, the high-voltage battery, as well as the power used to produce the battery cells, come exclusively from renewable sources.

A minimalist interior design focuses on a modern and more simplified look. This can be seen in the BMW iX's new "Shy Tech" concept, which enables its modern technology to blend into the background. Hidden switches, controls and embedded speakers allow for a cleaner look inside the car, while outside, the kidney grille houses camera technology, radar functions, state-of-the-art sensor technology and heating elements. Inside the cabin, a glassy iDrive controller is the main feature of the centre wooden console, framed by a sleek wooden panel. The controller's touch control capabilities replace conventional buttons for selecting iDrive menu options.

With the elimination of the centre tunnel, the rear bench seat offers ample room for a relaxing, lounge-like experience. The side seats also smoothly transition into the door trim, giving the passenger even more room to spread out on a long drive. The rear bench features optional heated seating as well as 3D speakers integrated into the headrests.






The iX has an available full-length "Sky Lounge" panoramic glass roof that can be electrochromatically shaded for more privacy. Without an interior liner, the glass roof allows for more headroom and creates a sense of space and relaxation.

For the first time in series production, the BMW Curved Display serves as the central display and control element. This 31 cm display forms a single unit by merging with the 38 cm control display and appears like an almost free-floating picture frame on the instrument panel. The new BMW iDrive enables natural and intuitive communication between you and your vehicle's intelligent digital assistant. The "Great Entrance Moments" creates a unique experience for the driver using ultra-wideband (UWB) radio technology to determine the distance between the key or smartphone and the car. As soon as the driver comes within three metres of the BMW iX, the vehicle begins its wake-up sequence and lighting display. Other iDrive features include automated climate control. displaying hazard warnings from other BMW vehicles and even the ability to predict where parking spaces may be available at your next destination.

Rafih Auto Group:

Unwavering support for Windsor Regional Hospital

hen it comes to big supporters of Windsor and Essex County, the Rafih Auto Group is right there at the top.

For well over two decades, the Rafih Auto Group has been donating to Windsor Regional Hospital (WRH). Most recently, their donations have been in support of the new hospital. According to Gisèle Séguin, Director of Public Affairs, Communications and Philanthropy at WRH, Terry Rafih, Chairman and CEO of Rafih Auto Group, was one of the first people in the community to come forward about how much he supported the new hospital.

"Terry Rafih is always thinking of the future," says Séguin. "He wants the whole community to be a part of making sure our hospital gets built so that we have the best health care in our community."

Séguin says that Rafih always gives back to the community in any way he can. Every year, he donates money raised from his annual charity golf tournament toward the development of the new acute care facility for the Windsor-Essex region. Séguin says it's a unique tournament because it brings people from different dealerships all over Ontario. In addition to his tournament, she says he is always supporting the WRH's tournaments and fundraisers.

"When plans were announced for a new state-of-the-art acute care hospital in Windsor, the Rafih Family immediately stepped up to support this important project that will serve the region for generations to come," says President and CEO of Windsor Regional Hospital David Musyj.

The current hospital facilities are outdated, undersized and do not meet modern standards infection control. In addition, with services divided between two hospital campuses, patients are regularly transferred between campuses for tests and procedures and medical staff also travel between sites to treat their patients.

Séguin says a new site will eliminate this inefficiency. It will also include ample parking, a helipad, and large private spaces for patients. At least 80% of the rooms will be single-

patient rooms to prevent the spread of infection and isolated ventilation systems will prevent the spread of airborne particles within the building.

"I think we provide the absolute best service we can with what we have, but our community deserves a state-of-theart acute care hospital with the best technology, facilities and equipment," says Séguin. "Our current facilities are not adequate for the services that we provide."

"Unwavering" in his support for the new hospital is how Séguin describes Rafih. She says he even supported the new hospital with his time by calling Ontario Premier Doug Ford to advocate for it on behalf of Windsor and Essex County citizens.

In addition, when the COVID-19 hit Windsor last year, and the hospital was in need of equipment, Séguin said Rafih was there right away with face masks and a cheque from the Lexus dealership to help ensure the hospital could get the PPE and equipment they needed. Séguin said she feels he's not recognized enough for what he does for the community.





"We thank the Rafih Auto Group, who have been strong supporters of Windsor Regional Hospital for several years," says Beth Ann Prince, Chairperson of the Board of Directors for the WRH Foundation. 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
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
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








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
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TAXTALK

If you are contemplating starting a business, a fundamental issue you would need to consider would be, "what form of business structure is best for me?" Although there are a myriad of business structures, the ones that are most commonly used are: Proprietorship, Partnership or a Corporation.

Proprietorship

Simply put, a proprietorship means you are in business for yourself. This is the easiest form of business structure and the costs are nominal. You can literally start this type of business instantaneously. All you have to do is to register it (if you are using a trade name) with the Provincial Government at nominal cost and even this requirement is waived if you choose to do the business in your own name.

Since the business is essentially, "you", all of the profits or losses are reported on your personal tax return. As is the case with most businesses, in the early years, the expenses usually exceed revenues. This creates a tax

opportunity as the losses can be offset against income from any other source.

As a sole proprietor, you are personally responsible for all the debts and obligations of your business. This means that all of your personal assets are exposed to risk. This is usually the most significant drawback of this type of business structure.

If you are in a high income tax bracket and if your business is profitable then you would likely pay more tax as a sole proprietor as opposed to, say, a corporate structure. This, again, is another significant reason why you would not consider a proprietorship.

Partnership

A partnership, essentially, is a group of proprietors carrying on business together with the intention of making a profit. It is easy to form and the costs are minimal, similar to a proprietorship. Partners include their prorata share of profit or loss on their personal tax returns.

Essentially, all of the advantages and drawbacks applicable to proprietorships are also applicable to partnerships. However, some of the advantages unique to a partnership structure are: combination of people with different talents, sharing of risks and ability to raise more capital for the business.

Some of the drawbacks unique to this structure are: potential for disagreement between the partners, disruption of the business upon the death, disability or retirement of a partner and potential exposure to risk caused by actions of a partner. It is, therefore, always a good idea to have a partnership agreement in place to minimize the impact of these drawbacks.

Corporation

A corporation is unique in that it is considered a separate "legal entity," apart and distinct from its owner. In fact, for tax purposes also, it is treated as a separate person than you, "the shareholder."

There are two distinct advantages for choosing this structure:

First, it offers liability protection. In other words, debts and obligations of the corporation are not considered your obligations and, therefore, the creditors of the business do not have a claim against your personal assets in case of business failure.

Second, a corporation, carrying on an active business, pays a much lower tax on the first \$500,000 of its taxable income (approximately, 12.5%, for an Ontario corporation.)

This provides a very significant benefit, particularly, in case where the shareholder's marginal tax rate is, say, 53.4%. In our example, on \$500,000 of taxable income, the tax difference would be \$204,000 which represents a significant tax deferral, provided that monies are left in the corporation. To the extent that you draw funds out of the corporation for personal use, the tax advantage is mitigated as you would pay tax on these withdrawals.

Another major advantage is the potential of taking advantage of lifetime capital gains exemption of \$892,000 if your business qualifies and you are able to negotiate the sale of shares of your business. This opportunity is only available within a corporate structure.


There are two major drawbacks to a corporate structure:


First, is the initial cost of setting up and yearly filing and maintenance costs. These could run a few thousand dollars, annually.

Second, and perhaps the most significant drawback, is the potential of losses being "trapped," within the corporation. Since the corporation is considered a separate entity for tax purposes, any losses that it sustains belong solely to it and, therefore, cannot be claimed by another person. This is a major disadvantage, particularly, if the shareholder has significant personal income from other sources.

The final choice of a business structure should always include a diligent review of all factors applicable to the fact situation.

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
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
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
